Maintenance and testing of Curtain Track JTRAC face and Ceiling fix

Maintenance

We would recommend from time to time that a visual inspection is carried out to ensure free running and that no parts are harmed or tampered with. The extruded aluminium track is powder coated with durable and strong high-quality coating which ensures low friction and resistance towards scratches. This, in conjunction with the chosen material for the runners, gives high performance without maintenance. The material for the runners is a POM-plastic (Polyoxymethylene) which is specifically used in industrial mechanic parts due to its low friction and strength, hence its suitability for curtain runners. No additional anti-friction applications shall be needed. The JTRAC is produced with the highest quality possible regarding materials and design which we believe gives the customer a more or less maintenance free product.

Testing

As a manufacturer, we see no future reason to perform annual testing regarding weight loading, providing the rail has been installed in accordance with our installation instructions and that visual inspections are provided to see that no parts are harmed or tampered with. As long as the installation and inspections have been conducted in the right manor the performance of the JTRAC testing shall be in alignment to the score from SP Technical Research Institute of Sweden.
